- Share a one-page A4 summary by email to the members the day before. Also, please share the paper with members to be read beforehand.
- In our Journal club, you need to focus on Methods and Tables of the paper if its quantitative survey. If there is a difficult part to understand, please share those points with members.
- Also, pay attention to the Good Literature referred in the Introduction and Discussion session as well.
